Children's House #1:

Dear Parents,

We are enjoying our new school year. Children's House #1 kids learned the letter 'b' along with its phonic sound in the month of September. They learned some words like bubble, banana, blueberry, blackberry, basketball, bumble bee because these words all start with the letter 'b'. Our little stars also enjoyed singing the 'bumble bee' song. There are so many butterflies made by our kids using zip-lock bags! Our "B fruit salad making" was exciting. We appreciate our parents effort for making this activity successful. The children also learned the color blue in this month. Children's House #1 kids worked with the numbers 1 and 2 in the month of September. They were asked to show their 1 finger, to close one eye, to touch one ear. Our kids also learned how to touch and feel any item with two fingers.

In this month our children learned the letters 'c' and 'd'. They learned about carrots, candy, crackers, cars, caterpillars, cookies, cheese as these words all start with the letter 'c'. We introduced the shape 'triangle' and the color 'orange'. We cut orange construction paper into a triangular shape to make a carrot.

We read the story book, Creepy Crawler and learned so many facts about caterpillars. Our children made "cheese sandwiches" and served themselves. While working with this activity they all showed hand eye co-ordination skills. In the second week of October we learned the letter "d". Our children learned some words like doll, dinosaur, dog, dragon, and dump truck as these words start with the letter "d". They enjoyed the game "dog feeding".

We welcomed Julia in Children's House #1. It's our pleasure to have her in our classroom.
